The budget report to the end of December was introduced by the Clerk together with some suggested amendments in the light of expenses incurred:

### 86.3 Budget for 2004/2005

The Meeting concluded at 20:16 pm.

The Clerk introduced the budget models he had prepared and then revised, following a review with the Finance Working Group. He drew particular attention to the budget for insurance. He reported that the estimated replacement cost for the War Memorial was £30-35,000 and this would equate to an additional annual premium of approximately £350.

After a discussion of the need to insure the memorial, it was proposed (RJ), seconded (AE) and agreed by a small majority that the memorial be added to the insurance policy and the insurance budget for next year increased accordingly.

Using the prepared models, discussion of key elements of the proposed budget ensued including particularly the list of proposed projects. Following the discussion *it was* proposed (RE), seconded (LF) and agreed that the precept for 2004/2005 be set at £17,800 and the Clerk was asked to formally request this from ESBC.
