376 - TN/24638/005: Waterside, Mires Brook Lane: Removal of one ash, three poplars and height reduction of twenty-three leylandi trees Received: 16/12/04 Replied: 23/12/04 Response: The Parish Council raises no objections to the proposed felling of the poplars or height reduction of the leylandii. Some concerns were expressed at the proposal to remove the ash tree, given that this was retained as part of the planning consent for the new house. Could raising the crown be considered as an alternative safeguard to the property that prevents the loss of this mature tree?

377 - CU/02131/008: Bagots Park Estate Farm Buildings: Change of use of part of building to form brewery and formation of service yard Received: 23/12/04 Replied: 06/01/05 Response: The Parish Council raises no objections to this application.

378 - PC/01967/055: Abbots Bromley School for Girls: Section 73 application of the 1990 Planning Act for the continued use of the Equestrian Centre and associated facilities without complying with condition 1 of PC/01967/053 dated 27/04/04 by use of the facilities for permanent commercial use.

Received: 29/12/04 Replied: 13/01/05 Response: The Parish Council supported the temporary relaxation of this condition and agrees that the current usage levels have not unduly inconvenienced residents. However, the Parish Council believes that had the original application been for unrestricted commercial use, it would have been rejected at this location due to the proximity of residential property, narrow access road and very difficult junction from the main street into Radmore Lane. For these reasons the Parish Council opposes a permanent relaxation of the condition, but would be willing to support continued temporary periods with reviews. A longer period of two or three years could be considered to ease the administrative burden on the school.

379 - HO/18950/012: Spring Bank Farm, Radmore Lane: Erection of single storey front, side and rear extensions plus alterations to roof Received: 06/01/05 Replied: 13/01/05 Response: The Parish Council raises no objections to this application.
