## 33. Minutes of Previous Meetings

**RESOLVED:** that the minutes of meeting held on 29<sup>th</sup> June 2011 should be signed as a true and correct record.

## 34. Matters of Report

## i. Road Safety – feedback from meeting with Cllr Atkins

The Chairman and Clerk reported back on the meeting held with Cllr Atkins. The main discussions of the meeting focussed on parking in the village and the areas which are currently causing hazardous driving conditions. At the meeting it was agreed that the only way forward was to have yellow lines painted in these areas and to address this a letter would need to be sent to the Parking Committee.

**RESOLVED:** that a letter should be sent to the Parking Committee requesting that yellow lines be installed at the Goose Lane junction and on the Goat Corner and that they should be priority. Lines should also be requested by Hall Hill Lane although this was not such high a priority.

In addition a speed check camera would also be installed on Uttoxeter Road to ascertain what speeds vehicles entering the village are actually travelling at. Cllr Charles advised that in the past higher speeds have been recorded nearer to the old police station and that this would be a good place to site the device.

## ii. Strategic Villages Meeting

Cllr R Mills gave a report on the Strategic Villages meeting, the group consists of representatives from Tutbury, Rolleston on Dove, Barton under Needwood, Abbots Bromley and Rocester Parish Councils – all of which have been identified by ESBC as potential villages for future develop.

ESBC has a target to build 15,000 new homes by 2026 and although many of these can be build on brownfield sites there is a shortfall of approximately 2000 and the above mentioned villages have been identified as locations to help address this. There are already several large scale applications in for Tutbury.

**RESOLVED**: that the Parish Council would need to monitor closely all applications as received and ensure that every application meets the requirements for the village, in particular sufficient parking spaces. Cllr Mills would attend the next meeting which was scheduled for end of July which would be with Mr O'Brien from ESBC. All details would be circulated to all councillors should they wish to attend.

#### iv Post Box

Cllr Hall had informed the Clerk that no progress had been made on a location for a small post box in the centre of the village although he had asked if councillors could suggest a suitable site.
