ii. Field Behind The Village Hall

It was agreed that the decision on how to proceed would be down to the Village Hall Committee and that the Parish Council will continue to support the Village Hall in whatever way they decide to move forward.

The Village Plan

Members discussed the current development boundary and the sites that had been identified by ESBC and landowners as potential development plots to accommodate the additional 40 homes that need to be provided. Each plot was discussed in terms of suitability for development, disruption to neighbours and the village, suitability of the road network and access. After some discussion the members agreed that at this stage the most suitable plots seemed to be the one on Uttoxeter Road at the edge of the village and the other the one on Lichfield Road next to the proposed sports field. However, it was agreed that more discussion and research would need to take place and further feedback would be needed from ESBC.

RESOLVED: that the clerk would liaise with ESBC to feedback on the council's initial discussions and how progress should be made to develop this further.
