127. Apologies for absence

128. Public Session

Mr A Sutton, Chair of Stop HS2 Action Group thanked people of Abbots Bromley for their support.

He updated the meeting on what HS2 would mean for the area. Impact on traffic around the Lichfield area would dramatic with over 3000 lorry movements per day. There are also rumours of A38 lane closures and this may impact on traffic through the village. The hybrid bill overrides any other planning bill and this could affect people within the village. There may also be a maintenance loop near Hill Ridware and aggregates coming in from Derbyshire.

Cllr Jarman highlighted the article in the Bulletin and offered that Mr Sutton could add to future Bulletins.

Mr Wheeldon reported back on the Neighbourhood Forum. Two proposals went in and both received positive feedback. Cllr Moore said that the Neighbourhood Forum do require that the money be used for specific items eg "the drive" for the sports ground. Funds also need to be match funded.

Mr Male asked about the agenda and how people know what items will be discussed during Group

Mr Male asked if the ESBC Planning Inspector had visited the village and visited the proposed site with a Parish Councillor or Councillors. Cllr Jarman and the Clerk confirmed that no such visit took place.

Mr Male also asked about the local plan and whether the Parish Council had concerns of the potential of the housing requirement being a 'minimum. Cllr Jarman confirmed that we do have concerns.

131. Matters of Report

i. Neighbourhood Development Fund

Update already provided as part of the Public Session, however, Cllr Mrs Moore confirmed that more work needed to be done by both organisations and requests for funding needed to be more specific. Cllr Ryan provided an updated regarding the field behind the Village Hall.

ii. Parish Council Surgery

Mrs Blower asked who would change the timers on the lights in the Church Yard. She was advised who to contact as this was not a Parish Council responsibility.

Mr Male asked why the village did not do a Neighbourhood Plan. Cllr Moore responded that often ESBC do not take any notice of these.

Mr Male asked if it would be possible to request a copy of the Inspector's Interim Report.

It was agreed that Cllr Charles would do the next surgery.

iii. Uttoxeter Schools.

Cllr Mrs D Burrows provided an update on the situation of Uttoxeter schools. In summary schools could move from a 3 tier system to a 2 tier system with first schools increasing the age from 9 to 11 years old.

Councillors agreed at the main concern for the village would be traffic and parking as numbers at the school would increase. Cllr Roy suggested a direct approach to Cllr Atkins rather than via the formal route. It was also agreed that Richard Clarke school should be contacted to ascertain their stance on the matter before a response made.

iv. Youth Club

Cllr Ryan said that the County Council is pulling all funding for youth services. Many youth clubs will cease on 31st December except for Abbots Bromley which is attempting to continue so now needs a committee and a constitution. Steve Coxon is the new chair, Jessica Coxon the secretary and Cllr Phil Ryan the treasurer. Cllr Ryan confirmed that they had now taken out their own insurance and have money in the bank. The children won a grant of £2000 for a fun day and whatever they take on the day will go in to the funds for the Youth Club. The event is not just to raise funds but also stimulate membership.
