Please ensure that containers are placed out at the kerbside for collection and that they are removed as soon as possible after the collection has taken place. Please note that Small WEEE needs to be presented at the side of the blue bin for collection.

The Council will not collect any waste on the dates marked with an X. These have been rescheduled to take place as follows: Wednesday 25th December will take place on Saturday 21st December, Thursday 26th December will take place on Saturday 28th December and Wednesday 1st January 2020 will take place on Saturday 4th January 2020. During the period 27th December to the 10th January 2020, up to 3 additional clear bin liners of blue bin recycling and up to 3 additional bin liners of grey bin waste may be put out for collection with your blue and grey bin.
