46. Neighbourhood Development Plan Update

Update provided by CIIr M Lockey

Malcolm Lockey and Paul Freeman, the new Chair and Vice-Chair of the NDPG, met with Tom Wheeldon, Secretary to the group on Saturday 5th September to review progress to date and to agree the next stage of work.

1. Although C-19 Lockdown restrictions prevented the working group from meeting, it has nevertheless provided valuable time for the Secretary to review all work undertaken to date, including the report produced by the initial working group and the detailed commentary by

- 2. As a result of this extended period of consultation, the Secretary has been able to collate all of the documentation produced by the group and, where appropriate, incorporate elements from the earlier report and has drafted a coherent document which will serve as the basis for discussion by the working group and the Parish Council. This has been a very significant undertaking.
- 3. Whilst the Policies element of the report is largely complete, the narratives which details the rationale underpinning the production of a Neighbourhood Plan and the Consultation processes is currently being re-drafted.
- 4. At this stage it is clear that the consultation process undertaken by the Parish Council/working group far exceeds that which is actually required but which allowed the greatest possible public contribution to the report which will, in effect, reflect community wishes.
- 5. The final section Strategy and Environmental Assessment is a generic element of the plan documentation and will be added by ESBC when the document is submitted to them for consideration.
- 6. It is intended that the draft report will be completed by the beginning of November. It will then be submitted to the Consultant for comment and amendment before the document is commercially printed and bound and then circulated to the working group and Parish Council for consideration. We aim to do this before the end of the year.
- 7. The working group and Parish Council owe a debt of gratitude to Tom Wheeldon for his considerable work on our behalf over recent months.

47. Matters of Report

i. Wildflowers

Cllr K Baker suggested that it would be good to try a different lane such as Woodmill Lane as residents were keen to mow the grass verges on Radmorewood Lane so that wildflowers were being cut off.
