Abbots Bromley Neighbourhood Plan

Following the receipt of informal comments from East Staffordshire Borough Council and advice from the Parish Council's planning consultant Urban Vision Enterprise, the Parish Council agreed to postpone the pre-submission consultation on the draft Neighbourhood Plan timed for December.

This consultation, under Regulation 14 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012, gives residents and businesses in the parish as well as various statutory bodies, the opportunity to influence the content of the plan before it is formally submitted to ESBC to be checked by an independent examiner.
